The interim laboratories of the Institute are located at Gurgaon in the NCR. THSTI is designed to be a dynamic and interactive organization with a mission to conduct innovative translational research and develop research collaborations across disciplines and professions to accelerate the development of concepts into tangible products to improve human health.

THSTI invites application for its Ph.D. program to conduct research in broad interdisciplinary areas such as: (a) Infectious diseases, (b) Tuberculosis, (c) Micronutrients and host immune response in pediatric diseases, (d) Biology of specific pediatric diseases, (e) Auto-immune diseases, infection and inflammation, Antibody Engineering for diagnostics and therapeutics, Medical devices, implants (f) Vaccine and anti-microbial development. Eligibility: Candidate must hold an MBBS, or Master's degree in life sciences, agriculture, veterinary science, engineering, or pharmacy. Only candidates holding a Junior Research fellowship (JRF) from CSIR-UGC, DBT, ICMR or DST-INSPIRE are eligible to apply. Candidates must have first division/class with at least 60% aggregate scores in all examinations from class 10 onwards. All educational and technical qualifications should be from a recognized university/board.

How to apply: Candidates fulfilling the above requirements may apply in the prescribed format to the Administrative Officer of the institute at the above address. Last date for receipt of applications is **16th Jan, 2013**. Applications received after the closing date will not be entertained on any ground including postal delay. Incomplete applications in any respect will be summarily rejected and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

Selection procedure: Candidates will be competitively short-listed based on the excellence of their academic records and the list of short-listed candidates will be published on THSTI website **by 24th January, 2013**. The personal interview for the short-listed candidates will be held during February 2013.
