

## Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2026/B/7192726-C3

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration
2. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

Tender invited for 3 years but policy will be renewed annually by paying annual premium.

#### **Responses to Pre-bid Queries: 11th February 2026**

##### **1) Whether it is an invasive procedure?**

**Response:** The GRASPP trial does not involve any invasive therapeutic intervention. The study evaluates a risk screening strategy for the identification of pregnant women at high risk of developing preeclampsia.

The screening components include:

- Clinical history assessment
- Blood pressure measurement
- Uterine artery Doppler (non-invasive ultrasound procedure)
- A peripheral venous blood sample for estimation of Placental Growth Factor (PIGF)

The only minimally invasive component is a routine peripheral venous blood draw, comparable to standard antenatal laboratory testing. No surgical or interventional procedures are performed as part of the trial.

##### **2) Whether any drug will be administered**

**Response:** The GRASPP trial does not involve any Investigational Medicinal Product (IMP). The study is designed to evaluate a screening strategy to identify pregnant women at high risk of developing preeclampsia. The trial procedures include clinical assessment, blood pressure measurement, uterine artery Doppler, and a blood sample for PIGF estimation.

Any use of low-dose aspirin in high-risk pregnancies is part of routine standard clinical care and is not a study intervention.

##### **3) AOO Limit?**

**Response:** The maximum liability payable for any single accident, incident, or occurrence under the policy shall be ₹1 crore.

##### **4) Per person limit in the event of death?**

**Response:** The maximum liability payable per participant in the event of death shall be ₹74 lakhs, subject to the overall Any One Occurrence (AOO) and Annual Aggregate (AOY) limits under the policy. This limit has been determined in alignment with the applicable CDSCO compensation framework for clinical trial-related injury or death.

## 5) Per location Limit

**Response:** The policy will be a single combined policy covering all three participating study sites. The total sum insured of ₹1 crore per policy year will apply collectively across all sites, with no separate per-location sub-limit.

## 6) If medical extension add-on cover required? If yes AOO limit ii) Per person limit

**Response:** Medical extension add-on cover is not required. All study-related medical management, including treatment of any trial-related injury, will be provided free of cost at the participating tertiary care hospitals, in accordance with institutional and regulatory requirements. Therefore, additional medical expense coverage is not necessary.

## 7) EMD: PSU' s are exempted:

**Response:** EMD and PBG are required from all bidders. However, EMD is exempted only for Central and State PSU companies. PBG is not exempted for any bidder

## 8) If it is long 3-year policy premium will be charged before issuance of policy in single go:

**Response:** Already clarified in tender document under point no 2 of buyer added bids specific T&C.

## Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.

12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
