- A) BRIC-Translational Health Science and Technology Institute (THSTI) is a part of the interdisciplinary Biotech Science Cluster at Faridabad in the National Capital Region. THSTI is a dynamic and interactive organization with a mission to conduct innovative translational research across disciplines and professions to accelerate the development of concepts into products to improve human health.
- B) Applications are invited for admission to the <u>Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Clinical Research (Specialisation</u> <u>in Clinical Trials</u>) for the academic session 2025-2027.
- C) Course details:
 - (i) This is a two-year, post-graduate degree course coordinated by BRIC-THSTI. The degree will be awarded by the Regional Centre for Biotechnology (RCB), recognized as an institution of National Importance by the Parliament of India, established by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India with regional and global partnerships synergizing with the programs of UNESCO as a Category II Centre
 - (ii) The course curriculum is enclosed as Annexure-A
 - (iii) The course will commence on September 29, 2025
 - (iv) Tuition fee: INR 25,000.00 per semester (there will be four semesters) For OBC/EWS, the fees will be INR. 18750.00 per semester, and for SC/ST/PwBD candidates, the fees will be INR.12500.00 per semester. In addition, University fees of INR. 5000.00 per semester, and examination fees of INR.1000 per semester. Those students who wish to avail hostel facilities will have to pay INR 45000.00 per semester. Fee waiver admissible to students from economically weaker sections as per Institution guidelines
 - (v) Facilities:
 - a. Hostel accommodation with mess (payment, at actuals)
 - b. State-of-the-art campus with many recreational facilities
 - c. Visit hospitals, industry, and clinical research/trials sites for hands-on training.
 - d. Internship with academic institutions, industry, research organizations, etc.
 - e. Engagement in actual ongoing clinical trials of the institution during the dissertation period for hands-on training
 - f. Support for placements
 - g. Possibility of continuing with Ph.D. subject to fulfillment of the THSTI Ph.D. policy.
- D) **Minimum eligibility criteria**: Graduation from a recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate in any of the following:
 - i) Bachelor's degree in Allopathic Medicine (MBBS)
 - ii) Bachelor's degree in other fields of Medicine/Dentistry/Nursing/Veterinary Science (BHMS/ BAMS/ BDS/ BSc Nursing/ BVSc)
 - iii) Bachelor's degree in Pharmacy/Life Sciences/Statistics/Public Health (B Pharm/BSc/ B Tech)

Note: Candidates awaiting their graduation results can also apply. They will be considered subject to submission of their graduation result (mark list and at least the provisional degree certificate) on the day of the interview.

E) Filling up of seats:

i) Number of seats: 15

ii) Reservations:

- 27% seats for Other Backward Classes (OBC) (non-creamy layer),
- 15% seats for Scheduled Castes (SC),
- 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribes (SC) (ST),
- 10% seats for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS), and
- 4% seats for the differently abled person (Person with Benchmark Disability, PwBD) are reserved for candidates belonging to these categories. SC/ ST/ OBC /EWS candidates are required to submit certificates in respect of their claims from authorized officers as notified by the Government for the purpose from time to time. The differently abled, (with a minimum of 40% disability) candidates are required to submit a certificate from authorized Medical Doctors/ Hospitals indicating the extent of their physical disability.

Please note: Certificates applicable to the reservations must be submitted in accordance to the format prescribed in the relevant Attachment (Attached).

F) Selection process:

Admission will be based on a two-step process: written test followed by an interview.

i. Eligibility for interview:

To be eligible for the interview, a candidate must:

- Score 60th percentile or above in the written test
- Obtain at least 40% marks in the written test
- ii. **Final selection:** The final score for admission will be a combination of the scores from written test and the interview
- iii. **Interview qualifying marks:** Candidates must score 60% or above in the interview to be considered for the final selection
- iv. Relaxation of 5% for OBC and 10% for SC/ ST may be applied to the above criteria, if required
- v. Location: The written test and interview will be held at BRIC-THSTI, Faridabad, Haryana, India
- vi. **Instructions:** all instructions pertaining to the syllabus, date, time, venue, etc. will be conveyed separately to candidate shortlisted based on the eligibility criteria, prior to the written test.
- G) Application process: The eligible and interested candidates must apply online via the Institute's website <u>https://recruitment.thsti.in/application/jobs</u> Applications through any other mode will not be accepted.

i. Procedure for filling up online application:

- ii. Documents to be kept handy before filling up the online application: (all the documents except (a) should be in pdf format) :

 - (c) Intermediate certificate (equivalent to 12th Standard) / Mark sheet
 - (d) Graduation degree certificate and Mark sheet
 - (e) Caste / Disability certificate (if applicable) in the format available as the relevant attachment.

Note:

- i. Candidates are required to keep a printout of the online application form by using the print button on the dashboard for future reference.
- ii. Providing false/ incorrect information in the application form or non-possession of essential qualifications detected at any stage of the selection process will lead to the disqualification of the candidate.
- iii. Incomplete applications will be rejected and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

H) Other conditions:

- i) During the course, the student must not apply for any other course/post-graduate program/ scholarship or appear for any examination or interview outside. If the student has applied for any of the above before applying for this program, she/he must provide the relevant information to this institution.
- ii) Candidate must ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility criteria as stipulated in the advertisement. If it is found that he/she does not fulfill the stipulated criteria by misinterpretation or any other reason during the selection process, the candidature of the candidate will be canceled. If the same is noticed after the admission, the candidate will be terminated following due process.
- iii) All future communications will be via email only.
- iv) All results/notifications will be published on the THSTI website; therefore, the candidates must visit the website regularly till the completion of the admission process.
